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Abstract

The studying of scientific families in Fez city is one of the important topics that need intense care by researchers, and that all directions must be familiarized with, because it is one of the pillars of civilizational development, especially those who are aware of the neglect of historians, so it is necessary to dive between the lines and historical texts. Which focused on some of the history of these families in order to shed light on the stages of their lives, their achievements, their civilizational efforts, and their scientific exploits. By the nature of the research and the duration of the study, the study included an introduction, a preface, and four chapters, as well as a conclusion that included the most important findings of the study, and then the appendices that included the most important sources and references that enriched the study with historical texts that are at the heart of the research topic. The preface included the primer history of the city and its establishment by Imam Idris II, with a statement of the reasons for its establishment and its geographical, economic, political and administrative components. As for the first chapter, it included the nature of the political and scientific life of Fez city during the studying period (400-800 AH / 1009-1397 AD), considering that the political situation is one of the most important elements and preparations for public life, including the scientific aspect. Therefore, this chapter included the nature of political life with attention to the historical sequence. While the second chapter came under the title of Scientific Families in Fez city, and we have detailed in this chapter a statement about mentioning the names of these families and their men, with interest in mentioning their genealogies, their first homes, the course of their migration and their reasons until they settled in Fez city, especially there are many scientific families coming to the city. The third chapter included the role of scientific families in the political and administrative life in Fez

city , with a statement of their position on this aspect, especially they occupied a large space in this field. While the fourth and final chapter included the role of scientific families in economic and scientific life, and a statement of their contribution in these two aspects, they had an effect on the economic side, including alms, endowments and donations.
