## Abstract

The study of the historical figures is considered a great importance in the field of the historical research, especially if these families have played a distinguished political or Scientific role, The study of the historical figures also reveal to us important historical aspects of the period in which these figures emerged both in the political and administration aspects, The historical figures varied in the variety of roles played by the caliphs , ministers , writers and leaders , especially in the Abbasid period ( 132-656/ 749-1258) that continued for five centuries that showed many of figures that played an important role in events .

This study dealt with one of the most prominent families that played an important role in the historical events of the Abbasid era They were Al-Baridiyun ( postalists ) ( 316-349/ 928-960 ) The period of the appearance of this family had witnessed serious changes experienced by the Abbasid caliphate among the most important changes in the Abbasid caliphate were the creation of the position of the caliphate in the era of caliphate al – Radi Bellah ( 322-329/ 933-940 ) which contributed to the weakness of the Abbasid caliphate, where the caliph lost all his political , financial and military powers.

The thesis was divided into three chapters dealing with the prelude to the Abbasid caliphate when the emergence of this family and beginning of their emergence and growing influence while the second chapter dealt with the relationship between the Baridoon family and Abbasid caliphate . The third chapter dealt with the relationship between the Baridoon family and the other powers like Al-Hamdani , Bhayen and the rulers of Oman The chapter also discussed the end of their influence in the Abbasid caliphate .
