المستخلص بلغة الرسالة توجيه البحث الى الدراسة :

هذه الرسالة مختصة بدراسة قضايا الغيب في القصص القرآني فجمعت بين العقيدة والتفسير ، أي أنها جمعت بين أهم علم وهو علم العقيدة وأهم كتاب وهو القرآن الكريم ، واختصت بقضايا الغيب فقط دون الإلهيات والنبوات .

وتناول الفصل الأول الملائكة (عليهم السلام) في القصص القرآني فشمّل تعريفهم لغة واصطلاحاً وخلقهم وحياتهم ومصدر علمهم وقدراتهم وامكاناتهم وتكليفهم وطاعتهم لله تعالى والأفضلية بينهم وبين البشر وعبادتهم وعصمتهم ووظائفهم في القصص القرآني .

وشمل الفصل الثاني الجنّ في القصص القرآني وفيه تعرفهم وخلقهم وحياتهم ومصدر علمهم وامكاناتهم وحدود قدراتهم .

وتخصّص الفصل الثالث بعالم البرزخ واليوم الآخر في القصص القرآني وتضمن الروح والقبر والساعة وأهلها واليوم الآخر والجنة والنار .

أما الفصل الرابع فوضح عقيدة القضاء والقدر في القصص القرآني وتضمن تعريف القضاء والقدر لغة واصطلاحاً والفرق بينهما والقدر والأخذ بالأسباب وعلاقة القضاء والقدر بالابتلاء وعلاقته بالأجل والقدر وأفعال العباد والقدر وإرادة الخير والشر في القصص القرآني.

ثم بينت في الخاتمة أهم النتائج التي توصلت إليها الرسالة والتوصيات التي يوصي بها الباحث

Abstract

All praise is due to Allah, peace and blessings be upon His Messenger Muhammad, His Family and All His Companions.

Some may ask, does the Qur'anic story has any concern in proving the issues of Islamic belief? Or is it for the lesson and referent and entertainment and confirmation only.

After I wrote on the subject of Qur'anic stories and its relationship to the Islamic conduct, my current thesis entitled (The issues of the unseen in the Qur'anic stories), related to the issues of the unseen only from the angels (peace be upon them), the jinn, the world of isthmus, the Resurrection and its horrors, the Last Day, Paradise and Hell, and the men on Al-A`raf and fate and destiny, it appears that the Qur'anic stories have a great and important role in proving issues and issues in the Islamic conduct, such as; The superiority between the angels (peace be upon them) and humans, the infallibility of the angels (peace be upon them), the existence of the jinn and their belief in them and their relationship with Satan, and the question of their death, and do they know the unseen? Do they have absolute capabilities and potential, or limited? And the torment and bliss of the grave, the proof of death, the Hour, the Resurrection, the deeds of the servants, the good and the bad, and their level.

The research included four chapters: Chapter One was dealt with angels (peace be upon them); their definition and the rule of belief in them, the origin of their creation, their life, their knowledge, and the limits of their abilities and capabilities through the Qur'anic stories. As for Chapter Two: it dealt with the jinn; defining them and the rule of belief in their existence, the origin of their creation, their life, their knowledge, and the limits of their abilities and potentials through the Qur'anic stories. While Chapter Three includes: The world of isthmus and the soul in the Qur'anic stories and begins with the definition of the soul and its relationship to the soul, the grave and its horrors, the Hour and the Last Day, Heaven and Hell and the owners of customs in the Qur'anic stories. As Chapter Four: It dealt with decree, predestination, the ruling of its denial, the relationship of predestination to taking the causes, the actions of the servants, the deadlines, their relationship to predestination, good and evil, and their ratio in the Qur'anic stories.

This thesis came as a supplement, to the doctoral dissertation (The Doctrinal Effects of Belief in Almighty God in the Qur'anic Stories), on theology by Dr. Bashar Shaalan Omar Al-Nuaimi, and his master's thesis (Prophecy Issues in the Qur'anic Stories), on Prophecies by Professor Farah Jassim Muhammad. As for the subject of this thesis is within the scope of the unseen or what some call (audiology).
