Abstract

The relationship between grammar and the Islamic sciences is a close and inseparable one, as grammar is indispensable for understanding the religious sciences. Grammar has a profound impact on comprehending Islamic legal rulings derived from the Book of Allah and the Sunnah of His Prophet ﷺ, and syntactic analysis (i' rāb) plays a major role in clarifying and highlighting meaning.

Allah Almighty has honored the Arabic language by making it the language of His Book and the Sunnah of His noble Prophet. Through this, it attained a distinguished status, elevation, and divine preservation. Allah also enabled eminent scholars who devoted themselves to serving this language. Among these distinguished figures is the erudite and meticulous scholar Abū 'Abd Allāh Shams al-Dīn al-Barmāwī (d. ٨٣١ AH), one of the most prominent scholars of Prophetic Hadith commentary. Among his most famous and greatest works is al-Lāmi' al-Ṣabīḥ fī Sharḥ al-Jāmi' al-Ṣaḥīḥ.

This book contains numerous grammatical phenomena that can be studied and researched independently due to the abundance of its issues. Therefore, a phenomenon worthy of attention and study was selected, namely the multiplicity of grammatical interpretations in the book al-Lāmi' al-Ṣabīḥ fī Sharḥ al-Jāmi' al-Ṣaḥīḥ. Due to the vast number of issues related to this topic, it was necessary to limit the study to a specific area. Since nouns are the most frequent and the clearest in exhibiting multiple grammatical interpretations, the research focused on them exclusively. Accordingly, the title of the study is:

“The Multiplicity of Grammatical Interpretations of Nouns in the Book al-Lāmi‘ al-Şabīḥ fī Sharḥ al-Jāmi‘ al-Şaḥīḥ by al-Barmāwī (d. ٨٣١ AH).”

After a thorough reading of the selected book, along with surveying and collecting the relevant scholarly material, the study plan proceeded with an introduction, four chapters, and a conclusion presenting the most significant findings. The introduction includes a brief account of al-Barmāwī’s life, his teachers, students, and works, followed by a definition of the multiplicity of grammatical interpretation and the reasons leading to its occurrence.
